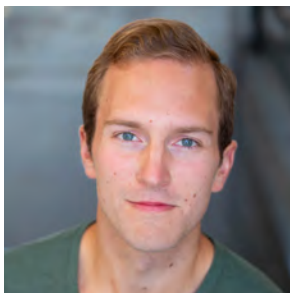

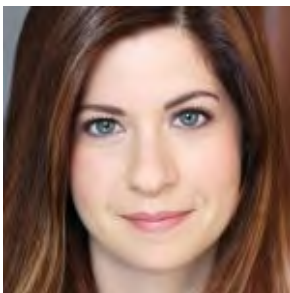

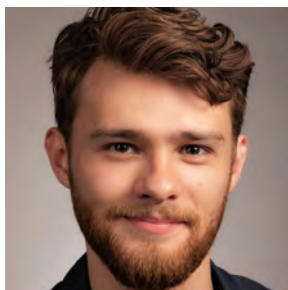

LOUISA MAY ALCOTT (Author - Novel) born in 1832 Louisa spent most of her life in Boston and Concord, Massachusetts, with her mother, father and three sisters. She grew up in the company of Ralph Waldo Emerson, Theodore Parker, and Henry David Thoreau. She taught briefly, worked as a domestic, and finally began to write. Alcott produced pot-boilers at first and many of her stories-notably those under the pen name "A.M. Barnard"-were lurid and violent tales. She volunteered as a nurse during the Civil War but contracted typhoid from unsanitary hospital conditions and was sent home. The publication of her letters in book form, *Hospital Sketches*, brought her the first taste of fame. Alcott's stories began to appear in *The Atlantic* and because family needs were pressing, she wrote the autobiographical *Little Women*, which was an immediate success. She followed *Little Women*'s success with two sequels. The novel has been turned into numerous movies, plays, operas and musicals. Alcott died in 1888 and was buried in Concord, Massachusetts, alongside her father, Emerson, and Thoreau.
